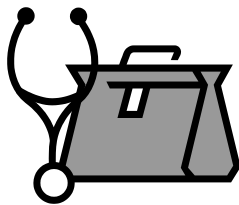

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HIV specialty care is important for people living with HIV/AIDS

*Everyone living with HIV/AIDS in the Philadelphia area can see an HIV specialist, **regardless of their ability to pay.***

HIV specialists are medical providers who:

- See a lot of people living with HIV/AIDS (at least 20 in the last 2 years)
- Keep up to date on HIV treatment changes



Regular dental care is important for people living with HIV/AIDS

It is recommended that everyone visit a dentist every six months. This is especially important for people living with HIV/AIDS, because:

- Gum disease causes an ongoing infection that can stress the immune system
- Symptoms of side effects and opportunistic infections (OIs) can appear in the mouth
